Redesignated 30 June 1947 as the 562d Engineer Utilities Detachment (Philippine Scouts)

Inactivated 20 February 1948 on Guam

Redesignated 18 November 1966 as the 562d Engineer Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 December 1966 at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland
