Inactivated 31 October 1945 in Germany

Redesignated 21 March 1951 as the 565th Engineer Welding Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 12 April 1951 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Inactivated 5 June 1952 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Redesignated 22 April 1965 as the 565th Engineer Detachment

Activated 4 May 1965 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 29 January 1972 in Vietnam

Activated 16 April 1980 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii

Inactivated 15 August 1988 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii

Activated 16 October 2007 at Honolulu, Hawaii


