Allotted 25 October 1951 to the Regular Army

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1954 as the 570th Engineer Company

Inactivated 25 March 1959 in Korea

Activated 24 June 1959 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 25 March 1963 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Assigned 3 December 1969 to the 5th Infantry Division and activated at Fort Carson, Colorado

Inactivated 15 December 1970 at Fort Carson, Colorado

Activated 21 June 1975 at Fort Polk, Louisiana
