Organized and Federally recognized 27 June 1921 in the Virginia National Guard at Parkley, Onancock, and Chincoteague as the 7th Company, 2d Provisional Regiment

Redesignated 12 October 1921 as Company K, 1st Infantry

Redesignated 9 March 1922 as Company K, 183d Infantry, an element of the 29th Division

Reorganized and redesignated 19 January 1924 Headquarters Company, 3d Battalion, 183d Infantry, and location changed to Onancock

Redesignated 22 February 1929 as Headquarters Company, 3d Battalion, 1st Infantry, an element of the 29th Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1940 as Headquarters Detachment, 3d Battalion, 1st Infantry

Redesignated 1 January 1941 as Headquarters Detachment, 3d Battalion, 176th Infantry, an element of the 29th Division

Inducted into active Federal service 3 February 1941 at Onancock

(176th Infantry relieved 12 March 1942 from assignment to the 29th Division)

Reorganized and redesignated 7 July 1942 as Headquarters Company, 3d Battalion, 176th Infantry

Inactivated 10 July 1944 at Fort Benning, Georgia

Converted and redesignated 2 July 1946 as Battery D, 691st Antiaircraft Artillery Automatic Weapons Battalion

Reorganized and Federally recognized 1 July 1947 at Onancock

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1949 as Battery D, 129th Antiaircraft Automatic Weapons Battalion, and assigned to the 29th Infantry Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 October 1953 as Battery D, 129th Antiaircraft Artillery Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 June 1959 as Battery D, 3d Automatic Weapons Battalion, 111th Artillery, and relieved from assignment to the 29th Infantry Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 November 1965 as Battery D, 3d Battalion, 111th Artillery

Redesignatedn1 November 1972 as Battery D, 3d Battalion, 111th Air Defense Artillery

Assigned 1 August 1975 to the 28th Infantry Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1988 as Detachment 1, Battery C, 3d Battalion, 111th Air Defense Artillery

Reorganized and redesignated 1 October 1990 as Battery C, 3d Battalion, 111th Air Defense Artillery

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2001 as Battery A, 3d Battalion, 111th Air Defense Artillery

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2002 as Battery C, 3d Battalion, 111th Air Defense Artillery

Ordered into active Federal service 27 January 2003 at Onancock; released from active Federal service 25 January 2005 and reverted to state control

Redesignated 1 October 2005 as Battery C, 3d Battalion, 111th Air Defense Artillery Regiment

Converted and redesignated 1 September 2007 as Detachment 2, 1173d Transportation Company

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2014 as Detachment 1, 1173d Transportation Company

Converted and redesignated 1 September 2017 as the 576th Engineer Detachment

Location changed 1 October 2019 to Virginia Beach

Ordered into active Federal service 17 April 2022 at Virginia Beach; released from active Federal service 21 May 2023 and reverted to state control
