Withdrawn 1 January 1938 from allotment to the Organized Reserves and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 15 July 1941 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Reorganized and redesignated 18 March 1943 as the 576th Engineer Dump Truck Company

Inactivated 30 May 1947 in the Philippines

Redesignated 17 December 1951 as the 576th Engineer Searchlight Company

Activated 18 January 1952 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 18 August 1952 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Redesignated 10 January 1967 as the 576th Engineer Company

Activated 1 March 1967 at Fort Carson, Colorado

Inactivated 15 May 1968 at Fort Carson, Colorado

Activated 17 October 2006 at Fort Carson, Colorado
