Inactivated 15 April 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 18 November 1948 as the 579th Engineer Foundry Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 17 January 1949 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 14 September 1953 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Redesignated 6 October 1955 as the 579th Engineer Detachment

Activated 29 October 1955 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Activated 1 July 1965 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 16 October 1971 in Vietnam
