Activated 3 May 1947 on Guam as a Philippine Scout unit

Inactivated 20 February 1948 in the Mariana Islands, and withdrawn from the Philippine Scouts

Redesignated 11 September 1950 as the 57th Engineer Heavy Shop Company

Activated 1 October 1950 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Allotted 13 September 1951 to the Regular Army

Reorganized and redesignated 15 January 1953 as the 57th Engineer Company

Inactivated 20 September 1975 in Germany

Activated 16 October 2008 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina
