Redesignated 27 June 1947 as the 584th Engineer Light Equipment Company

Activated 20 July 1947 in Korea

Inactivated 25 January 1949 in Korea

Redesignated 15 November 1954 as the 584th Engineer Company; concurrently allotted to the Regular Army and activated at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Inactivated 23 September 1958 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Activated 26 March 1963 at Fort Dix, New Jersey

Inactivated 1 April 1972 in Vietnam

Activated 1 September 1980 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 31 July 1988 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia
