Redesignated 7 May 1930 as the 585th Engineer Company

Withdrawn 1 January 1938 from the Organized Reserves and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 August 1941 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Reorganized and redesignated 18 March 1943 as the 585th Engineer Dump Truck Company

Inactivated 15 September 1948 in Japan

Redesignated 26 May 1959 as the 585th Engineer Company

Activated 24 June 1959 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 29 January 1972 in Vietnam

Activated 16 September 1980 in Germany

Inactivated 15 August 1988 in Germany

Activated 16 September 2005 at Fort Lewis, Washington


