Redesignated 27 June 1947 as the 591st Engineer Light Equipment Company

Activated 20 July 1947 in Korea

Inactivated 25 January 1949 in Korea

Redesignated 17 May 1966 as the 591st Engineer Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 July 1966 at Fort Campbell, Kentucky

Inactivated 1 January 1972 in Vietnam

Activated 16 September 2007 at Fort Campbell, Kentucky


