Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1953 as the 595th Engineer Company

Inactivated 21 February 1955 in Korea

Activated 25 February 1966 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Inactivated 14 December 1970 in Vietnam

Activated 16 April 1980 at Fort Shafter, Hawaii

Inactivated 15 August 1988 at Fort Shafter, Hawaii
