Activated 24 May 1944 in Italy

Reorganized and redesignated 20 January 1945 as the 1712th Engineer Service Detachment

Redesignated 5 April 1945 as the 1712th Engineer Map Depot Detachment

Inactivated 8 September 1945 in Italy

Redesignated 19 August 1965 as the 600th Engineer Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 September 1965 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 17 February 1969 in Vietnam

Withdrawn 3 May 2004 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 16 October 2007 at Des Moines, Iowa
