Activated 30 September 1944 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Reorganized and redesignated 10 March 1945 as the 1723d Engineer Utilities Detachment

Inactivated 25 June 1946 at Marseille, France

Redesignated 19 August 1965 as the 606th Engineer Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 September 1965 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Inactivated 17 February 1969 at Tuy Hoa, Vietnam

Withdrawn 3 May 2004 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 16 October 2007 at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma

Location changed 20 January 2011 to Mustang, Oklahoma

Ordered into active military service 30 May 2014 at Mustang, Oklahoma
