### **608th ENGINEER DETACHMENT**

Constituted 6 September 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 1746th Engineer Service Detachment

Activated 1 October 1944 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii

Redesignated 6 April 1945 as the 1746th Engineer Map Depot Detachment

Inactivated 23 May 1946 in Korea

Redesignated 19 August 1965 as the 608th Engineer Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 September 1965 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Inactivated 17 February 1969 in Vietnam

Withdrawn 3 May 2004 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 16 October 2010 at Vicksburg, Mississippi


