Reorganized and redesignated 10 April 1945 as Company A, 602d Army Engineer Camouflage Battalion

Inactivated 2 March 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 21 July 1949 as Company A, 47th Army Engineer Camouflage Battalion, and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 15 August 1949 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Reorganized and redesignated 20 July 1954 as the 610th Engineer Company

Inactivated 25 March 1963 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Activated 1 July 1966 at Fort Irwin, California

Inactivated 20 March 1972 in Vietnam

Activated 16 May 2007 at Fort Lewis, Washington
