Constituted 29 November 1948 in the Organized Reserve Corps as the 652d Engineer Ponton Bridge Company

Activated 31 December 1948 at Fergus Falls, Minnesota

Location changed 10 April 1949 to Elbow Lake, Minnesota; on 3 April 1951 to International Falls, Minnesota

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1954 as the 652d Engineer Company

Location changed 18 May 1959 to Ellsworth, Wisconsin; on 16 November 1984 to Joliet, Illinois; on 15 September 1997 to Ellsworth, Wisconsin

Ordered into active military service 10 February 2003 at Ellsworth, Wisconsin; released from active military service 14 June 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 1 July 2010 to Hammond, Wisconsin
