Assigned 26 August 1941 to the 25th Infantry Division

Activated 1 October 1941 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii

Reorganized and redesignated 1 January 1944 as the 65th Engineer Combat Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1954 as the 65th Engineer Battalion

Inactivated 15 August 2005 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, and relieved from assignment to the 25th Infantry Division

Headquarters and Headquarters Company activated 16 October 2007 at Fort Shafter, Hawaii (Support Company concurrently constituted and activated)

Assigned 16 October 2014 to the 2d Brigade Combat Team, 25th Infantry Division (Support Company concurrently inactivated and lettered companies activated)
