Reorganized and redesignated 9 June 1944 as the 1463d Engineer Maintenance Company

Inactivated 22 December 1945 at Camp Stoneman, California

Redesignated 17 November 1948 as the 665th Engineer Maintenance Company, and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 8 December 1948 at Butler, Pennsylvania

Inactivated 24 October 1950 at Butler, Pennsylvania

Redesignated 8 June 1954 as the 665th Engineer Company

Activated 2 July 1954 at Easton, Pennsylvania


