Inactivated 31 October 1945 at Camp Shanks, New York

Allotted 12 November 1948 to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 1 December 1948 at New York, New York

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 15 September 1953 as the 668th Engineer Company

Location changed 14 July 1958 to Fort Tilden, New York

Inactivated 1 May 1959 at Fort Tilden, New York

Activated 16 September 2008 at Orangeburg, New York

Ordered into active military service 8 November 2011 at Orangeburg, New York; released from active military service 11 December 2012 and reverted to reserve status
