Redesignated 2 November 1948 as the 672d Engineer Light Equipment Company; concurrently allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 5 December 1948 at Missoula, Montana

Inactivated 31 August 1950 at Missoula, Montana

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 16 April 1956 as the 672d Engineer Company

Activated 7 May 1956 at Kalispell, Montana

Inactivated 1 June 1959 at Kalispell, Montana

Activated 16 September 2008 at Missoula, Montana
