Reorganized and redesignated 15 November 1944 as the 2857th Engineer Service Detachment

Redesignated 6 April 1945 as the 2857th Engineer Gas Generating Detachment

Inactivated 20 May 1946 on Okinawa

Redesignated 20 February 1952 as the 67th Engineer Gas Generating Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 20 April 1952 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Reorganized and redesignated 28 July 1954 as the 67th Engineer Detachment

Inactivated 30 June 1971 in Vietnam

Activated 16 April 1980 at Fort Shafter, Hawaii

Inactivated 15 August 1988 at Fort Shafter, Hawaii

Activated 16 October 2004 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri
