Constituted 4 January 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 680th Engineer Topographic Company, Corps

Activated 17 February 1944 at Fort Jackson, South Carolina

Inactivated 7 January 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 3 November 1948 as the 680th Engineer Dump Truck Company; concurrently allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 19 November 1948 at Connellsville, Pennsylvania

Location changed 30 December 1949 to Belle Vernon, Pennsylvania

Ordered into active military service 11 September 1950 at Belle Vernon, Pennsylvania

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Released from active military service 10 July 1952 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 15 November 1952 at Belle Vernon, Pennsylvania

Redesignated 5 November 1962 as the 680th Engineer Company

Activated 28 March 1963 at Lewes, Delaware

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at Lewes, Delaware

Activated 16 June 2007 at Canandaigua, New York
