Constituted 16 November 1948 in the Organized Reserve Corps as the 688th Engineer Maintenance Company

Activated 30 November 1948 at Lafayette, Louisiana

Location changed 1 August 1950 to Houma, Louisiana

Reorganized and redesignated 1 December 1951 as the 688th Engineer Field Maintenance Company

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 28 September 1953 as the 688th Engineer Company

Ordered into active military service 15 October 1961 at Houma, Louisiana; released from active military service 4 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at Houma, Louisiana

Activated 16 February 2008 at Harrison, Arkansas

Ordered into active military service 13 April 2008 at Harrison, Arkansas; released from active military service 17 May 2009 and reverted to reserve status
