Redesignated 1 April 1942 as the 710th Engineer Depot Company

Redesignated 29 May 1943 as the 710th Engineer Base Depot Company

Activated 21 June 1943 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Inactivated 2 December 1945 at Camp Myles Standish, Massachusetts

Redesignated 29 April 1947 as the 68th Engineer Base Depot Company

Activated 15 March 1948 on Okinawa

Inactivated 1 June 1949 on Okinawa

Redesignated 11 September 1950 as the 68th Engineer Depot Company

Activated 22 September 1950 at Granite City, Illinois

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1953 as the 68th Engineer Company
