Constituted 8 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 704th Engineer Petroleum Distribution Unit

Activated 20 December 1942 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Redesignated 24 July 1943 as the 704th Engineer Petroleum Distribution Company

Inactivated 5 December 1946 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Redesignated 25 March 1948 as the 704th Engineer Dump Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 9 April 1948 at Utica, New York

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Ordered into active military service 14 August 1950 at Utica, New York

Reorganized and redesignated 27 March 1954 as the 704th Engineer Company

Released from active military service 26 April 1955 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 1 August 1959 at Utica, New York

Activated 16 February 1983 at Texarkana, Arkansas

Location changed 16 November 1993 to Pine Bluff, Arkansas

Inactivated 15 January 1996 at Pine Bluff, Arkansas

Activated 17 September 2008 at Hot Springs, Arkansas
