Redesignated 20 August 1931 as the 716th Engineer Company

Location changed 15 April 1937 to New York, New York

Redesignated 1 April 1942 as the 716th Engineer Depot Company

Ordered into active military service 1 December 1943 at New York, New York

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 30 June 1948 in Germany

Redesignated 15 April 1959 as the 716th Engineer Company

Activated 11 May 1959 at Winooski, Vermont

Location changed 1 December 1960 to Burlington, Vermont

Inactivated 1 February 1963 at Burlington, Vermont

Activated 16 September 2008 at Somersworth, New Hampshire

Ordered into active military service 17 June 2015 at Somersworth, New Hampshire; released from active military service 1 June 2016 and reverted to reserve status
