718th ENGINEER COMPANY

Constituted 26 November 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 718th Engineer Depot Company

Activated 15 December 1943 at Camp White, Oregon

Inactivated 9 March 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 14 April 1948 as the 718th Engineer Dump Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 27 April 1948 at Knoxville, Tennessee

Location changed 1 November 1950 to Oak Ridge, Tennessee

Inactivated 1 August 1951 at Oak Ridge, Tennessee

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 18 May 1954 as the 718th Engineer Company

Activated 31 August 1954 at Oak Ridge, Tennessee

Location changed 15 September 1957 to Albany, Georgia

Ordered into active military service 1 October 1961 at Albany, Georgia; released from active military service 10 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

718th ENGINEER COMPANY

Location changed 31 December 1965 to Atlanta, Georgia; on 10 February 1971 to Forest Park, Georgia; on 15 December 1977 to Chamblee, Georgia; on 15 November 1997 to Fort Benning, Georgia

Ordered into active military service 14 July 2006 at Fort Benning, Georgia; released from active military service 9 January 2008 and reverted to reserve status
