Allotted 20 November 1951 to the Regular Army

Reorganized and redesignated 28 March 1954 as the 71st Engineer Detachment

Inactivated 25 March 1958 in Japan

Activated 15 March 1960 in Korea

Inactivated 1 January 1966 in Korea

Activated 1 December 1966 at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland

Inactivated 13 May 1968 at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland


