**733d ENGINEER COMPANY**

Constituted 1 April 1927 in the Organized Reserves as the 733d Engineer Depot Company

Organized in October 1929 at Seattle, Washington

Location changed 20 April 1931 to Portland, Oregon

Redesignated 20 August 1931 as the 733d Engineer Company

Location changed 14 May 1937 to Los Angeles, California

Redesignated 1 April 1942 as the 733d Engineer Depot Company

Ordered into active military service 15 March 1944 at Camp Van Dorn, Mississippi

Inactivated 31 May 1946 in the Philippines

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Activated 31 March 1948 at Los Angeles, California

Location changed 4 December 1950 to Redmond, Oregon

Redesignated 15 December 1950 as the 733d Engineer Aviation Depot Company

Ordered into active military service 10 June 1951 at Redmond, Oregon

Reorganized and redesignated 20 July 1951 as the 733d Engineer Aviation Supply Point Company

Released from active military service 10 September 1955 and reverted to reserve status

## 733d ENGINEER COMPANY

Reorganized and redesignated 1 January 1956 as the 733d Engineer Aviation Depot Company; concurrently location changed to Klamath Falls, Oregon

Redesignated 1 February 1957 as the 733d Engineer Company

Inactivated 1 August 1959 at Klamath Falls, Oregon

Activated 16 September 2008 at Greenville, Tennessee


