Inactivated 13 December 1945 at Camp Patrick Henry, Virginia

Redesignated 27 December 1946 as the 503d Engineer Utilities Company

Activated 20 January 1947 in Germany

Inactivated 1 September 1947 in Germany

Redesignated 19 April 1948 as the 739th Engineer Dump Truck Company and allotted — to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 15 May 1948 at San Francisco, California

Inactivated 31 August 1950 at San Francisco, California

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 16 September 1980 as the 739th Engineer Company

Activated 16 March 1985 at East St. Louis, Illinois

Location changed 1 November 1997 to Granite City, Illinois

Ordered into active military service 21 January 2003 at Granite City, Illinois; released from active military service 6 June 2003 and reverted to reserve status
