Activated 5 January 1944 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Inactivated 15 April 1946 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Allotted 19 May 1948 to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 19 June 1948 at Salt Lake City, Utah

Reorganized and redesignated 9 September 1948 as the 744th Engineer Heavy Equipment Company

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 10 July 1953 as the 744th Engineer Company

Inactivated 11 April 1955 at Salt Lake City, Utah

Activated 5 June 1959 at Salt Lake City, Utah

Ordered into active military service 1 October 1961 at Salt Lake City, Utah; released from active military service 6 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 29 February 1968 at Salt Lake City, Utah

Activated 16 September 2008 at Ogden, Utah
