Redesignated 15 March 1948 as the 760th Engineer Maintenance Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Activated 29 March 1948 at Fort Myer, Virginia

Inactivated 9 August 1950 at Fort Myer, Virginia

Redesignated 21 June 1955 as the 760th Engineer Company

Activated 18 July 1955 at Grundy, Virginia

Location changed 9 January 1956 to Marion, Virginia; on 18 March 1957 to Bristol, Virginia; on 6 March 1959 to Marion, Virginia

Inactivated 15 April 2000 at Marion, Virginia

Activated 16 September 2008 at Marion, Virginia
