Activated 1 September 1942 at Camp White, Oregon, as Headquarters, Headquarters and Service Company, 50th Engineer Combat Regiment

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1945 as the 1084th Engineer Maintenance Company

Inactivated 2 November 1945 at Camp Gruber, Oklahoma

Redesignated 13 January 1948 as the 797th Engineer Ponton Bridge Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 6 February 1948 at Frederick, Maryland

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 25 May 1950 as the 797th Engineer Panel Bridge Company

Reorganized and redesignated 15 October 1953 as the 797th Engineer Company

Inactivated 1 June 1959 at Frederick, Maryland

Activated 16 September 2008 on Guam
