Activated 20 July 1947 in Korea

Inactivated 25 January 1949 in Korea

Redesignated 21 July 1965 as the 7th Engineer Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 August 1965 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Inactivated 17 February 1969 in Vietnam

Activated 16 October 1986 in Panama


