Constituted 8 July 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 518th Engineer Company

Activated 5 August 1942 in Northern Ireland

Redesignated 17 December 1942 as the 518th Engineer Water Supply Company

Inactivated 25 October 1945 at Camp Shanks, New York

Redesignated 6 July 1948 as the 801st Engineer Water Supply Company; concurrently allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 30 July 1948 at the Presidio of San Francisco, California

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 15 September 1952 at San Francisco, California

Redesignated 15 October 1956 as the 801st Engineer Company

Activated 1 November 1956 at Redding, California

Inactivated 1 January 1958 at Redding, California

Activated 1 May 1959 at Sacramento, California

Location changed 1 April 1963 to the Presidio of San Francisco, California; on 1 September 1975 to Oakland Army Base, California; on 25 July 2000 to Vallejo, California


