811th ENGINEER COMPANY

Organized 24 May 1881 in the Ohio National Guard at Lancaster as Company E, 6th Infantry (Mt. Pleasant Guards)

Redesignated 22 December 1885 as Company I, 14th Infantry

Mustered into Federal service 9 May 1898 at Camp Bushnell, Ohio as Company I, 4th Ohio Volunteer Infantry; mustered out of Federal service 20 January 1899 at Columbus and reverted to state control as Company I, 14th Infantry

Redesignated 14 April 1899 as Company I, Unattached Infantry

Redesignated 14 July 1899 as Company I, 4th Infantry

Redesignated 9 July 1900 as Company F, 7th Separate Infantry Battalion

Redesignated 20 June 1901 as Company F, 7th Infantry

Redesignated 2 June 1913 as Company L, 4th Infantry

Mustered into Federal service 11 July 1916 at Camp Willis, Ohio; mustered out of Federal service 3 March 1917 at Fort Wayne, Michigan

Called into Federal service 15 July 1917; drafted into Federal service 5 August 1917

Reorganized and redesignated 20 August 1917 as Company L, 166th Infantry, an element of the 42d Division

811th ENGINEER COMPANY

Demobilized 17 May 1919 at Camp Sherman, Ohio

Reorganized and Federally recognized 23 February 1921 in the Ohio National Guard at Lancaster as the 2d Separate Company of Infantry

Redesignated 1 May 1921 as Company G, 4th Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 1 July 1921 as Company G, 166th Infantry, an element of the 37th Division

Inducted into Federal service 15 October 1940 at Lancaster

Relieved 1 February 1942 from assignment to the 37th Division (37th Division concurrently redesignated as the 37th Infantry Division)

Inactivated 22 February 1944 at Camp Hood, Texas

Reorganized and Federally recognized 12 May 1947 in the Ohio National Guard at Lancaster as Company G, 166th Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1959 as Company D, 1st Battle Group, 166th Infantry, an element of the 37th Infantry Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1963 as Company A, 1st Battalion, 166th Infantry

Consolidated 1 October 1967 with the 2d Rifle and Weapons Platoon, Company A, 1st Battalion, 166th Infantry (see ANNEX) and consolidated unit designated as Company A, 1st Battalion, 166th Infantry; location concurrently changed to Circleville

(1st Battalion, 166th Infantry, assigned 15 February 1968 to the 38th Infantry Division)

Location changed 1 September 1968 to Tarlton

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 February 1972 as Company D, 216th Engineer Battalion, and relieved from assignment to the 38th Infantry Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 January 1993 as Detachment 1, Company C, 216th Engineer Battalion

811th ENGINEER COMPANY

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1993 as Detachment 1, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 216th Engineer Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1997 as Detachment 1, Company A, 216th Engineer Battalion

Ordered into active Federal service 18 December 2003 at Tarlton; released from active Federal service 16 April 2005 and reverted to state control

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2007 as the 811th Engineer Company

Location changed 15 June 2010 to Amanda

Organized and Federally recognized 12 May 1921 in the Ohio National Guard at Circleville as the 145th Motor Company, 37th Division Quartermaster Trains, an element of the 37th Division

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 15 May 1936 as Company C, 112th Quartermaster Regiment

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 9 February 1937 as Headquarters Battery, 136th Field Artillery

Reorganized and redesignated 12 May 1937 as Headquarters Battery and Combat Train, 3d Battalion, 136th Field Artillery

Reorganized and redesignated 8 June 1937 as Service Battery, 136th Field Artillery

Inducted into Federal service 15 October 1940 at Circleville

Disbanded 1 February 1942

Reorganized and Federally recognized 8 May 1947 in the Ohio National Guard at Circleville as Company I, 166th Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1959 as the 1st Rifle and Weapons Platoon, Company D, 1st Battle Group, 166th Infantry, an element of the 37th Infantry Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1960 as the 2d Rifle and Weapons Platoon,
Company A, 1st Battle Group, 166th Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1963 as the 2d Rifle and Weapons Platoon,
Company A, 1st Battalion, 166th Infantry


