**812th ENGINEER COMPANY**

Organized in October 1879 at Wooster as the Wooster City Guard, an independent militia company

Mustered into the Ohio National Guard 26 February 1881 as Company D, 8th Infantry Regiment

Mustered into Federal service 13 May 1898 at Camp Bushnell, Ohio, as Company D, 8th Ohio Volunteer Infantry Regiment; mustered out of Federal service 21 November 1898 at Wooster

Reorganized and redesignated 14 April 1899 as Company D, Unattached Infantry

Redesignated 21 July 1899 as Company D, 8th Infantry Regiment

Mustered into Federal service 19 June 1916 at Camp Willis, Ohio; mustered out of Federal service 22 March 1917 at Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana

Called into Federal service 15 July 1917

Drafted into Federal service 5 August 1917

Reorganized and redesignated 15 September 1917 as Company D, 146th Infantry, and assigned to the 37th Division

Demobilized 20 April 1919 at Camp Sherman, Ohio

Reorganized, redesignated, and Federally recognized 18 October 1920 in the Ohio National Guard at Wooster as Company D, 2d Infantry Regiment

Redesignated 20 December 1920 as Company K, 3d Infantry Regiment

## **812th ENGINEER COMPANY**

Reorganized and redesignated 1 July 1921 as Company K, 145th Infantry, an element of the 37th Division (later redesignated as the 37th Infantry Division)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1928 as Headquarters Company, 73d Infantry Brigade

Inducted into Federal service 15 October 1940 at Wooster

Disbanded 1 February 1942 at Camp Shelby, Mississippi

Reconstituted, reorganized, redesignated, and Federally recognized 28 March 1947 in the Ohio National Guard at Wooster as Company H, 145th Infantry, an element of the 37th Infantry Division

Ordered into active Federal service 15 January 1952 at Wooster

(Company H, 145th Infantry [NGUS] organized and Federally recognized 15 January 1954)

Released from active Federal service 15 June 1954 and reverted to state control; Federal recognition concurrently withdrawn from Company H, 145th Infantry (NGUS)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1959 as Company D, 1st Battle Group, 145th Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1963 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2d Battalion, 145th Infantry, and relieved from assignment to the 37th Infantry Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1968 as Company A, 1st Battalion, 145th Infantry

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 June 1974 as Troop L, 3d Squadron, 107th Armored Cavalry

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 May 1977 as Company A, 112th Engineer Battalion

(112th Engineer Battalion assigned 1 September 1999 to the 38th Infantry Division)

Ordered into active Federal service 30 January 2003 at Wooster; released from active Federal service 28 January 2005 and reverted to state control

## 812th ENGINEER COMPANY

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 September 2007 as Company E, 1st Battalion, 145th Armored Regiment, and assigned to the 2d Brigade Combat Team, 28th Infantry Division

Relieved 1 March 2008 from assignment to the 2d Brigade Combat Team, 28th Infantry Division

Ordered into active Federal service 25 September 2008 at Wooster; released from active Federal service 29 October 2009 and reverted to state control

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 September 2010 as the 812th Engineer Company


