Organized 4 April 1937 in the Texas National Guard at Kingsville as Battery F, 3d Battalion, 133d Field Artillery Regiment, an element of the 36th Infantry Division

Inducted into Federal service 25 November 1940 at Kingsville

Reorganized and redesignated 19 January 1941 as Battery F, 2d Battalion, 133d Field Artillery

Reorganized and redesignated 9 February 1942 as Battery F, 2d Battalion, 202d Field Artillery

Relieved from assignment 11 February 1942 to the 36th Infantry Division

Reorganized and redesignated 8 February 1943 as Battery C, 961st Field Artillery Battalion

Inactivated 27 November 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Reorganized and Federally recognized 7 July 1947 as Company F, 141st Infantry, an element of the 36th Infantry Division

Reorganized and redesignated 16 March 1959 as Company D, 4th Armored Rifle Battalion, 144th Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 1 January 1960 as Company A, 1st Battle Group, 141st Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1963 as Company A, 2d Battalion, 141st Infantry

836th ENGINEER COMPANY

Reorganized and redesignated 1 January 1976 as Detachment 1, Company B, 2d Battalion, 141st Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1985 as Company E, 2d Battalion, 141st Infantry

Consolidated 1 September 1994 with Company E, 3d Battalion, 141st Infantry (organized and Federally recognized 1 August 1984 at San Benito), and consolidated unit designated as Company E, 3d Battalion, 141st Infantry

Converted and redesignated 1 September 1996 as Company A, 386th Engineer Battalion

Ordered into active Federal service 26 June 2004 at Kingsville; released from active Federal service 22 December 2005 and reverted to state control

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2007 as the 836th Engineer Company

Ordered into active Federal service 30 March 2008 at Kingsville; released from active Federal service 3 May 2009 and reverted to state control
