Activated 25 October 1944 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Reorganized and redesignated 5 May 1945 as the 3104th Engineer Fire Fighting Platoon

Inactivated 1 June 1946 in Germany

Redesignated 5 February 1953 as the 84th Engineer Firefighting Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 10 April 1953 in Korea

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1954 as the 84th Engineer Detachment

Inactivated 1 May 1964 in Korea

Activated 5 April 1965 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Inactivated 23 August 1968 in Vietnam

Activated 1 August 1988 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Inactivated 15 February 1996 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Activated 16 October 2008 at Fort Lewis, Washington


