Constituted 5 September 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 3105th Engineer Service Detachment

Activated 25 October 1944 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Reorganized and redesignated 5 May 1945 as the 3105th Engineer Fire Fighting Platoon

Inactivated 25 June 1946 in France

Redesignated 5 February 1953 as the 85th Engineer Firefighting Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 10 April 1953 in Korea

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1954 as the 85th Engineer Detachment

Inactivated 1 January 1966 in Korea

Activated 1 December 1966 at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland

Inactivated 23 August 1968 in Vietnam

Activated 16 August 1988 in Korea
