Constituted 22 November 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 2865th Engineer Gas Generating Detachment

Activated 8 January 1945 on Saipan

Inactivated 19 December 1945 on Saipan

Redesignated 19 November 1965 as the 865th Engineer Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 17 November 1965 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 26 December 1971 at Cha Rang, Vietnam

Activated 1 December 1980 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 15 September 1997 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Withdrawn 3 May 2004 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 16 September 2010 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Ordered into active military service 14 November 2014 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina


