Organized and Federally recognized 1 May 1971 in the Georgia Army National Guard at Fort Stewart, Georgia as the 75th Engineer Detachment

Ordered into active Federal service 30 January 2003 at Fort Stewart, Georgia; released from active Federal service 28 January 2005 and reverted to state control

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2007 as the 175th Engineer Platoon and location changed to Hinesville

Consolidated 31 August 2017 with the 874th Engineer Detachment (see ANNEX 1); consolidated unit designated as the 874th Engineer Detachment at Toccoa

Ordered into active Federal service 28 March 2020 at Toccoa; released from active Federal service 27 March 2021 and reverted to state control

Constituted 1 September 2007 in the Georgia Army National Guard as the 874th Engineer Detachment

Consolidated 1 June 2015 with the 876th Engineer Company (see ANNEX 2), and consolidated unit designated as the 874th Engineer Detachment at Toccoa
