Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2005 as the Sustainment Troops Battalion, 81st Armored Brigade Combat Team

Ordered into active Federal service 16 August 2008 at home stations; released from active Federal service 19 September 2009 and reverted to state control

Location changed 1 October 2011 to Marysville

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2015 as the 898th Engineer Battalion
