Constituted 1 September 1995 in the Washington Army National Guard as the 898th Engineer Battalion and organized from new and existing units

Organized and Federally recognized 10 May 2000 at Everett

Reorganized 1 September 2000 in the Washington and California Army National Guard as the 898th Engineer Battalion

Ordered into active Federal service 15 November 2003 at home stations; released from active Federal service 12 May 2005 and reverted to state control

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2005 in the Washington Army National Guard as the Special Troops Battalion, 81st Armored Brigade Combat Team

Ordered into active Federal service 16 August 2008 at home stations; released from active Federal service 19 September 2009 and reverted to state control

Location of Headquarters changed 1 October 2011 to Marysville

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2015 as the 898th Engineer Battalion

Reorganized 1 September 2016 in the Washington and Oregon Army National Guard as the 898th Engineer Battalion

Reorganized 1 August 2018 in the Washington Army National Guard as the 898th Engineer Battalion
