Redesignated 1 August 1942 as the 94th Engineer General Service Regiment

Inactivated 22 December 1945 at Camp Myles Standish, Massachusetts

Redesignated 16 May 1946 as the 94th Engineer Construction Battalion

Activated 27 May 1946 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Reorganized and redesignated 20 September 1953 as the 94th Engineer Battalion

Inactivated 27 November 1954 in France

Activated 10 March 1955 in Germany
