Constituted 19 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 961st Engineer Maintenance Company

Activated 25 January 1943 at Camp Swift, Texas

Inactivated 31 December 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 4 April 1947 as the 961st Engineer Dump Truck Company and concurrently allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 8 May 1947 at Rochester, Indiana

Location changed 10 July 1947 to South Bend, Indiana

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Ordered into active military service 11 September 1950 at South Bend, Indiana; released from active military service 10 July 1952 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 15 December 1952 at South Bend, Indiana

Redesignated 1 May 1956 as the 961st Engineer Company and activated at Evansville, Indiana

Location changed 1 May 1959 to Detroit, Michigan

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at Detroit, Michigan

Activated 16 September 2008 at Sharonville, Ohio

Ordered into active military service 13 April 2009 at Sharonville, Ohio; released from active military service 17 May 2010 and reverted to reserve status
