990th ENGINEER COMPANY

Constituted 7 February 1944 in the Army of the United States as Company C, 1268th Engineer Combat Battalion

Activated 27 March 1944 at Camp Maxey, Texas

Inactivated 25 January 1946 in the Philippines

Allotted 27 February 1947 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 12 March 1947 at Hackensack, New Jersey

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as Organized Reserve Corps)

Redesignated 16 June 1948 as Company C, 469th Engineer Combat Battalion

Location changed 15 October 1948 to Jersey City, New Jersey

Reorganized and redesignated 13 September 1949 as Company C, 469th Engineer Aviation Battalion

Ordered into active military service 1 June 1951 at Jersey City, New Jersey
(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 1952 as Army Reserve)

Released from active military service 25 September 1955 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 5 December 1955 to Hackensack, New Jersey; on 1 May 1957 to Camden, New Jersey; on 15 February 1963 to Jersey City, New Jersey

Redesignated 30 December 1965 as the 990th Engineer Company and concurrently inactivated at Jersey City, New Jersey

990th ENGINEER COMPANY

Activated 16 September 2008 at Fort Dix, New Jersey

Ordered into active military service 1 February 2017, released from active military service 7 March 2018 and reverted to reserve status
