Activated 13 November 1950 in Korea

Allotted 25 October 1951 to the Regular Army

Reorganized and redesignated 25 May 1964 as the 4th Finance Section

Inactivated 30 June 1971 in Korea

Consolidated 1 May 1993 with the 4th Finance Battalion (active) (see ANNEX) and consolidated unit designated as the 4th Finance Battalion
