172d INFANTRY REGIMENT (THE MOUNTAIN BATTALION)

Constituted 1 September 1982 in the Vermont Army National Guard as the 72d Infantry, a parent regiment under the Combat Arms Regimental System, and organized to consist of Company A

Redesignated 1 April 1983 as the 172d Infantry

Expanded and reorganized 1 December 1983 to consist of Company A, and the 3d Battalion

Reorganized 1 October 1984 in the Vermont, Maine, New Hampshire, and New York Army National Guard to consist of the 3d Battalion

Withdrawn 1 May 1989 from the Combat Arms Regimental System and reorganized under the United States Army Regimental System with Headquarters at Jericho, Vermont

Reorganized 1 September 1992 in the Vermont, Maine, New Hampshire, and Rhode Island Army National Guard to consist of the 3d Battalion

Redesignated 1 October 2005 as the 172d Infantry Regiment

Reorganized 1 September 2007 in the Vermont, Maine, and New Hampshire Army National Guard to consist of the 3d Battalion, an element of the 86th Infantry Brigade Combat Team

(3d Battalion ordered into active Federal service 5 December 2009 at home stations; released from active Federal service 8 January 2011 and reverted to state control)
