**29th INFANTRY  
(THE PIONEERS)**

Constituted 2 February 1901 in the Regular Army as the 29th Infantry

Organized 5 March 1901 at Fort Sheridan, Illinois

Assigned 29 July 1918 to the 17th Division

Relieved 10 February 1919 from assignment to the 17th Division

Assigned 1 October 1933 to the 4th Division

Relieved 16 October 1939 from assignment to the 4th Division

Inactivated 31 October 1946 in Germany

Activated 1 May 1949 on Okinawa

Assigned 2 December 1954 to the 23d Infantry Division

Relieved 1 March 1956 from assignment to the 23d Infantry Division

Reorganized 25 May 1957 as a parent regiment under the Combat Arms Regimental System

Withdrawn 11 September 1987 from the Combat Arms Regimental System, reorganized under the United States Army Regimental System, and transferred to the United States Army Training and Doctrine Command
